



Under the Smoke Free Environment Legislation Act all Market Buildings and Structures have been deemed Smoke Free Areas.

All business owners in the Market are responsible for informing their workers that under the **Smoke Free Environment Legislation Act** smoking inside Market Buildings and structures is prohibited.

Fines for smoking in these areas under the Act are:

- Persons smoking in a smoke free area.. \$550.00
- Occupiers allowing persons to smoke in a smoke free area:

| - Persons         | \$1,100.00 |
|-------------------|------------|
| - Body Corporates | \$5,500.00 |

## SYDNEY MARKETS RULES

Rule 8, Part (b) states:

"An Occupier must not in the Markets smoke any substance or any cigar, cigarette, pipe **or other device** in an area of the Markets SML has designated as an area in which smoking is prohibited."

This rule includes E-Cigarettes and Comply Notices will be issued if in breach of this rule.
