DO NOT START WORK UNTIL YOU HAVE READ & UNDERSTOOD THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS

All Persons Conducting a Business or Undertaking (PCBU) are responsible for identifying hazards, assessing risks and ensuring appropriate controls are in place to ensure the safety of their workers and visitors to the workplace. The information is provided by Sydney Markets Limited to assist Occupiers and their contractors carry out their works safely and to meet their Work, Health & Safety (WHS) legal obligations



SYDNEY MARKETS WHS RULES (Summary) CAUTION ٨ A LIVE BUILDING SERVICES NO SMOKING Live building services run throughout Sydney Markets including through the demised p All enclosed areas of Sydney Markets and other designated areas are non-smoking Isolation of a service may not isolate all services within your work area properties an inspection, identify hazards and implain services. WORK PERMITS A work permit must be obtained from the Sydney Markets Limited prior to commencing the following work processes and Treat all building services as live unless positively and individually identified as isolated or de-energised by a li conditions attached to the permit must be observed at all times. Permits include but are not limited to ensed and competent persons are to carry out any work associated with live building set Hot Works - for work that generate a naked flame, smoke or sparks. Personal protective equipment must be appropriate for the work activity to be under Excavating penetrating & trenching - for work that require drilling, coring, cutting, chasing or excavating. LOADING DOCKS Powered Nailing Tool – for work using low velocity EPT, gas combustion powered tool and pneumatic (compressed air) nail tools. Only authorised personnel are to enter into loading docks area Obeyed all dock signage. Do not drive in pedestrian exclus Hazardous Work Area - some work areas/tasks may be assessed as having a high risk with such areas requiring a permit. Roof Work Permit – prior to accessing any roof areas controlled by Sydney Markets Limited Be aware of moving vehicles and plant (e.g. delivery trucks, forklifts). Ensure appropriate personal protective equipment (in acc (e.g. high-visibility clothing). Elevated Work Platform (EWP) - required if using an EWP owned or controlled by Sydney Markets Limited ACTIVITIES NOT TO IMPACT ON QUIET ENJOYMENT Only use plant or equipre nent (e.g. compactors, dock levellers, etc.) that you are trained, co Building activities which impact quiet enjoyment of Occupiers and patrons must be undertaken outside of trading hours. This Be aware of dock edges and only use ladder or stair access provided. Do not jump down from raised docks includes any extended trading hours. Such activities include: d housekeeping matters immediately to a cleaner or Sydney Markets Limited. Clean up the spill if you can, or protect the area with barricades to pre-time for the area to be attended to noisy works or works that create excessive vibration such as scabbling, drilling and fixing to a structure; Report all spills and any sline whilet was works which generate dust or fumes (e.g. painting, installing membranes) that cannot be contained fully within the demised RIP HAZARDS premises Be aware of trip hazards such as wheel stops, kerbs and expansion joints throughout Sydney Markets BEHAVIOUR WITHIN SYDNEY MARKETS SAFETY IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY. IDENTIFY HAZARDS, ASSESS AND CONTROL ANY RISKS TO YOURSELF AND OTHERS. Behaviour must not offend, harass or upset patrons, Sydney Markets Limited staff, Occupiers or other workers. This includes loud or offensive language or comments, playing of loud music, horseplay and sexual harassment such as wolf whistling. EMERGENCY PROCEDURES DRUGS AND ALCOHOL Know the location of your nearest: Possession or use of illegal drugs or drug devices or behaviour causing suspicion of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol are not tolerated and may result in your removal from Sydney Markets. Alcohol must not be consumed during any work period. **Emergency Fire Exit Fire Extinguisher** EXIT 1 RUBBISH AND WASTE Fire Hose Reel Fire Hydrant Rubbish and/or waste must not to be placed in bins located in Plaza areas which are provided for patrons use Occupiers and their contractors must remove all thier trade waste from Sydney Markets. If this is not practicable, contact Sydney **ALERT TONE** Markets Limited "BEEP, BEEP, BEEP" "WHOOP, WHOOP, WHOOP" Liquid wastes must not be discharged into waste points. Liquid waste must be containerised, removed and disposed of in accordance with authority (EPA) requirements Prepare to evacuate, secure and make Immediately evacuate via nearest USE OF ELECTRICITY worksite safe emergency exit Power must only be drawn from General Power Outlet (GPO) that have Residual Current Device (RCD) protection within the demised premises. If power supply is not available in the demised premises prior to fit-out commencing, contact Sydney Markets EXIT Limited to discuss alternative arrangements. Do not draw power from outside the demised premises without permission from Do not return to your workplace, vehicle or equipment until authorised Sydney Markets Limited OTHER REQUIREMENTS by Sydney Markets Limited + Hoarding must be maintained in a safe condition and hoarding doors must be kept securely closed at all times POLICE For all Emergency Services dial 000 • Specific permission from Sydney Markets Limited must be obtained prior to completing any building works outside the demised premises and/or hoarding and contact Sydney Markets AMBULANCE management or security Ŵ Caution <u>/ľ</u> Spills Traffic areas **Building services** Loading dock access Trip Hazards Report all spills to Sydney Markets Limited Look out for trip hazards stair access provided Wear Hi-Viz clothing services as live
